Dear friend:

Our Roshi, Rev. Hakuun Yasutani will be with us until the end of October this year. Beginning next year, he will spend six months in Japan and six months in the United States each year. His stay in the United States will be from July through December.

It was decided at the last meeting of the Zen Studies Society to increase the monthly dues for regular members to thirteen dollars starting on September 1st, 1966. This support is necessary to care for the Roshi and to cover the expenses of maintaining our three Zendo's in New York, Philadelphia and Washington.
