Dear Friend

The Zen Studies Society is the operating entity for Dai Bosatsu Zendo Kongo-ji, a Mountain Monastery and Shobo-ji, the New York City Zendo. At this time the Zen Studies Society faces a limitless future with a strong past guided by Roshi Eido Tai Shimano, Abbot of Dai Bosatsu and his wife, Aiho, the manager of Shobo-ji. I and many Sangha members recently celebrated Eido Roshi's sixty-fifth birthday and his twenty-fifth year directing the Zen Studies Society and I expect this dynamic team to continue bringing the practice of Rinzai Buddhism to the United States and Europe for years to come.
